You will also be required on occasion to work away from home on other Environet sites across the UK to support other operational managers.

### Main Responsibilities

Area Operations Managers report and are accountable to their respective Regional Director on all operational issues. Their roles and responsibilities include but are not necessary limited to:

- Responsibility for all projects allocated to them as Project Owner (typically in their geographical area, although possibly in other areas too) to include herbicide work and all physical removal work (Xtract™, Resi-Dig-Out™, site supervision etc.). Typical tasks include;
  - To liaise with clients to arrange works and attend any pre-start meetings with the corresponding consultant or Senior Regional Manger
  - To prepare site paperwork such as permits to dig, RAMS, check sheets, spray records etc.
  - To order plant, machinery, and haulage for waste as required
  - To liaise with and arrange spray operatives, plant operators and labourers as necessary to ensure projects are properly resourced.
  - To supervise all works on site, ensuring Environet's high standards of work are met.
  - To complete Post Treatment Management Plans and guarantee certificates
- Aid Consultants and Regional Directors where requested (i.e. where geography or availability dictate) and carry out surveys, record the necessary information to enable the sales team to prepare the necessary sales proposal.
